Implemented by the Deutsche Gesellischaft für internationale Zusammenarbeit [GIZ] and Engagement Global gGmbH with its Service Agency Communities in One World on behalf of the Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development, In cooperation with the German Water Partnership [GWP] and the German Association of Local Public Utilities (VXU).

OVERALL PARTNERSHIP RESULTS

- Impressing how fast the partners have engaged in a deep bond and have started working on the ground. This usually takes much longer.
- Dozens of missions and job shadowings have taken place in the past years. Partners also visited fairs together.
- During the difficult times of the Russian-Ukrainian war, dozens of aid deliveries were organized for the Ukrainian water supply companies with urgently needed water equipment. → Restoration of essential water infrastructure with the help of German partners.
- Partnership-based cooperation not only leads to progress in hard skills, but also in soft skills.
- The close professional exchange regularly contributes to building reliable relationships.
- Utility partnerships make it clear that long-standing local problems can often be successfully solved through an exchange with external perspectives.







GELSENWASSER, EMSCHER EGLV – LUKANGA (ZAMBIA)

- Start of the partnership: 2021
- **Rehabilitation of the pumping station** at Mushimbili Dam in Kapiri Town serving **65,000 people**.
- **Rehabilitation** and relaunch of an **elevated tank** in Chisamba town for over 15,000 people
- Relaunch of a wastewater treatment plant in Kapiri Moshi, which had been shut down for 10 years (for approx. 6,000 people)
- Improvement of the water loss strategy
- Installation of meters, improvement of the Geographic Information System (GIS) to manage and monitor the drinking water network
- Introduction of an **asset management** system.





HAMBURG WASSER, HANSEWASSER – MIYAHUNA, AMMAN (JORDAN)



- Start of the partnership: 2021
- The main focus areas of the partnership are **optimization of drinking water production, water quality and KPI system, wastewater and sludge management**.
- Highlight: While working on the optimization of drinking water production during the partnership, the dosing points for chemicals (coagulation metering room, polymer inlet flocculation), and filtration were improved. Among other technical impacts, this also resulted in **monthly average cost savings of more around 38,600 EUR.**

HAMBURG WASSER, NETZE BW – KASHWASA AND KUWASA (TANZANIA)

- Start of the partnership: 2022
- Developing a more accurate information base about the water system e. g. NRW, leakages, pressure, flows
- Joint problem-solving on reducing chemical consumption, conduct jar tests for flocculant etc., optimizing filter backwash processes and dosing points etc.
- Trainings on and new software for the **GIS system**

"GIS has allowed us to simplify working procedures, i. e. our meter readers do not need to go to site to identify new customers because this task is done by technical technicians by correct capturing of coordinates and shared to all other stakeholders." (quote KUWASA staff)

- Introduction of new **human resource** management tools
- Potential support through UWCI for KUWASA from 2025 on 24. April 2024



OOWV, WUPPERVERBAND – BCMM BUFFALO CITY (SOUTH AFRICA)

- Start of the partnership: February 2022
- set-up of water quality monitoring plans and joint development of ideas for setting up protection zones at the water source
- Set-up of automatic systems for internal and external wastewater testing processes (LIMS and logbook)
- joint school campaign on world water day at the three operator locations in Germany and South Africa
- Formation of **new working routines**



DRESDEN, TORGAU, PLAUEN – LUAPULA (ZAMBIA)

- May 2022 to July 2023: Funding by Utility Platform
- August 2023 to now: Funding by the EU-program of the Global Water Operators' Partnership Alliance (GWOPA)
- The rather short project provided a **bridging function** until the partnership transitioned to the EU program of GWOPA
- Consolidation of the partnership by doing a twoweek fact-finding mission → Partners became highly motivated to work together and learn from each other.
- Until summer 2023, partners had defined five thematic work areas



WHAT ARE SOLIDARITY OPERATOR PARTNERSHIPS?

Focus of the solidarity operator partnerships in Ukraine: **Procurement of necessary technical equipment** and **accompanying peer-to-peer exchange** for the maintenance and sustainable organization of service provision and the rehabilitation of critical infrastructure.



SOLIDARITY OPERATOR PARTNERSHIPS

As of April 2024: 16 active partnerships with Ukrainian operators.



DRESDEN, BERLIN, COLOGNE – LVIV, TERNOPIL, NADVIRNA (UKRAINE)



- Start of the partnerships: Lvivvodokanal in 2021, Ternopilvodokanal and Nadvirnavodokanal: 2022
- Two weeks after the start of the full-scale war, a **relief convoy** with urgently needed generators and chemicals for water purification was organized for Lviv.
- Ukrainian delegations have been making regular visits to Germany, e.g. in June 2023 female Ukrainian laboratory technicians participated in a specialized laboratory course conducted by the German Regional Association Sachsen-Thüringen for Water, Wastewater and Waste.
- Donation of a big vehicle for Ternopil. Additional equipment for Ternopil and Lviv is ready for transport and will be sent in the next weeks.

OOWV – CHERNIHIV AND SUMY (UKRAINE)



- Start of the partnership: September 2022
- Since the beginning of the full-scale war, both Miskvodokanal (Sumy) and Chernihivvodokanal have been
 affected by Russian military attacks. Partnership with the OOWV aims to support in rebuilding the
 destroyed water operator's infrastructure. The main focus of these partnerships is to assist Ukrainian
 utilities in resuming their daily operations through targeted procurements.
- Visits in Germany and knowledge exchange between the utilities are also planned for the upcoming months, such as participation in the ReBuild Ukraine Conference in Warsaw and the Ukrainian-German Partnership Congress in Leipzig.
- A laboratory course for female Ukrainians took place. 24. April 2024
