1. Needs Assessment





1. Needs Assessment

Principle of SEDD:

Technical assistance deliveries causally caused by Russian war of aggression

Step 1:

- \rightarrow Requirements list priority A B C
- \rightarrow Technical evaluation
 - · Compatibility with existing plant components
 - Alternatives
 - Influence of technical parameters on the overall system

Step 2:

 \rightarrow What is possible beyond that?



2. Purchasing Process vs. Formal Requirements

2.1 Involvement of Specialized Departments

\rightarrow Supplier structures – Technical Purchasing Dept.

- Can existing framework agreements and long-term supplier contracts be used?
- Are new suppliers required?
- Involvement of the contracting and awarding department to ensure legally compliant order processing
- \rightarrow Availability of goods
- \rightarrow Delivery times
- \rightarrow Supply chain (sanctions list check!)



SEDD is a public sector enterprises and may not use taxpayers' money for purposes other than those for which it is intended \rightarrow Financing of technical assistance goods is not investment provision)





2. Purchasing Process vs. Formal Requirements

2.1 Quotation, Tender, Documentation

\rightarrow Value of the components - Contract and Procurement Department

- Is a call for tenders required? If so,
 - Comparison of offers
 - Free award of contract
 - Restricted invitation to tender
 - Public invitation to tender
 - EU Threshold Regulation

\rightarrow Documentation

- Every step must be documented (e.g. request for quotation, offers, order confirmations; correspondence, etc.)
- Necessity to archive digitally
- Audit-proof



3. Logistics

3.1 Transport

- \rightarrow Recommendation: NGO "Go Local"
 - Supported by GIZ
 - Located in Ukraine
 - Hub on the Polish-Ukrainian border





- \rightarrow Experience with resident forwarder
- \rightarrow Handling possible sometimes more time consuming
- → Frequency of handling with GoLocal significantly higher (more experience)



3. Logistics

3.2 Customs Issues - Overview

Standard package of documents:

- 1. **Donation Agreement** (or Donation certificate) for these goods between the donor and consignee (Lvivvodokanal) to confirm humanitarian aid.
- 2. Proforma invoice
- 3. Packing list
- 4. Export declaration (EX1) → Export Accompanying Document (MRN) Even in the case of humanitarian aid this document is needed that cargo could leave EU territory
- 5. Declaration of humanitarian aid for Ukrainian customs (prepared by GoLocal)
- 6. Letter-Order (or Letter -Request) from the sender or consignee to Golocal for the delivery of the cargo





3.2 Customs Issues

- \rightarrow EORI-No. of the shipper
 - EORI number (Economic Operators' Registration and Identification number) = customs number
 - to apply for the first consignment by the shipper
- → Customs service provider recommended in case one using another freight forwarder than GoLocal \rightarrow include provision for customs clearance

4. Goods receipt

Final Steps

- → Request proof of export from the transporter \rightarrow important for VAT-free delivery, which is currently possible in DE (export declaration)
- \rightarrow GIZ handover protocol
- → City Council Letter
- \rightarrow Picture Documentation
- \rightarrow Handover of Manuals
- \rightarrow Online meetings for initial operation
